- Work in conjunction with site managers and assistant managers to make sure maintenance schedules and routines are being performed and equipment maintained to maximize quality and efficiency.
- Perform tunnel repairs and new equipment installations including, but not limited to:
 - Advanced electrical work and control wiring
 - Plumbing maintenance
 - o Installing, dismantling, repairing, and reassembling machinery and equipment
 - Metal fabrication/welding
- Keep machinery functioning at peak levels by planning and executing preventative maintenance.
- Improve the skills of direct reports by coaching, training, and mentoring.
- Set an example for the team by working well independently or with teammates and by demonstrating a high sense of urgency and purpose.
- Prior experience supervising a maintenance team.
- Extensive experience in plumbing, electrical, and commercial building maintenance.
- Solid experience with 3-phase high voltage, AC/DC, and distribution panels.
- Experience working with and repairing hydraulic systems, pneumatics, and commercial conveyor systems.

Cleaning and Maintenance:

- Observe wash systems for performance and take action to troubleshoot & report any issues found.
- Utilize or replace water hoses, nozzles, brushes, soap buckets, brooms, hand tools, pressure washer, and grease gun.

- Ensure vacuums are working properly.
- Monitor and control chemicals daily and monthly.
- Troubleshoot any issues that arise with chemical/soap usage.
- Conduct daily preventive maintenance according to scheduling to prevent equipment downtime as much as possible.
- Conduct initial and periodic checks throughout the day on all equipment. Perform cleaning procedures of equipment daily.
- Conduct equipment repairs proactively and troubleshoot problems quickly. Work with company technicians when necessary.
- Review all equipment updates and maintain service records.

Safety & Security:

- Maintain a safe environment by always utilizing the proper safety equipment for each task.
- Lift properly.
- Utilize safety glasses and gloves when handling chemicals.
- Stay clear of the conveyor when in motion, utilize emergency stop when working on or near the conveyor.
- Never step in front of a vehicle entering wash or being guided by the conveyor.
- Open and/or close the facility securing all entry points.

Supervisory Responsibilities:

- Provide continuous training and coaching of each employee to maximize them to their fullest abilities.
- Maintain a professional appearance and keep personnel clean and uniforms neat in appearance.
- Lead by example and continuously train staff in equipment maintenance.
